

UTAH MOTORBOAT ACCESS ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

LOST CREEK RESERVOIR GRANT APPLICATION

PROJECT TITLE AND LOCATION

Asphalt access (Lost Creek Road) to Lost Creek Reservoir is situated in an open setting 12 miles northeast of Croyden, Utah in Morgan County. The reservoir rests at the 6,000-foot elevation and has a 360-acre surface area. The Francis Canyon and Lost Creek Dam USGS maps cover the area.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project includes the rehabilitation of approximately 9 miles of asphalt road, having an average width of 28'.

The recreation use at Lost Creek Reservoir is day-use only, with higher visitor numbers from May to September on holidays and weekends.

PURPOSE AND NEED

Lost Creek Reservoir is a popular fishing destination. The oil access road is in need of repair. Though a wake-less reservoir many fisherman haul small boats to launch at the ramp. Over the years use and nature has modified cross slopes, and eroded shoulders and pavement.
