Duties:

- Providing information to the public and answering park specific questions, regulations concerning camping and day-use activities, and surrounding recreational opportunities on public lands.
- Assisting with park operation by daily fee collection, reporting and accounting at the entrance station and visitor center.
- Assisting in the gift shop by selling retail items, stocking and doing inventory.
- Performing general maintenance and cleaning of park facilities, basic plumbing and construction jobs as necessary and maintaining park hiking and biking trails.
- Developing and presenting a variety of interpretive programs including evening programs, guided hikes, and Jr. Ranger programs. Assisting with special projects and other duties as assigned.

Work is performed in a remote setting with limited resources and conveniences. Ranger aides must live on site in a two-bedroom, dormitory-style setting and will be required to work weekends and holidays. **Housing is free.**
