

Do you want to become a Junior Ranger?


Here is what you'll need to accomplish:






BOAT RESCUE


Help the boat below get back to the marina by finding a way through the maze.


Life Jacket - one for everyone on the boat

Life Ring - called a Type IV PFD



LIFE JACKET SAFETY


All children under 13 years of age must wear a life jacket when boating. As a Junior Ranger you should encourage all boaters to wear a Coast Guard approved life jacket.


