

RULES

Please help us continue to offer this unique experience, to the visitors of Jordanelle State Park, by complying with these rules.

- **Leave it the way you found it.** Unfortunately, we do not have the resources to treat the Cabins like a hotel room. You are responsible for light cleaning and removing all garbage from the Cabin the same as you would do in a campsite.
- **There is NO SMOKING in the Cabins.** Please be considerate of the people who will stay in the Cabins after you and smoke outside. If doors and windows are open, please smoke away from the cabin. Please dispose of butts properly and not on the ground.
- **Pets are not allowed.** Due to the fact that pets shed and leave a mess, pets are not allowed inside, on the deck, or around the Cabins.
- **You may not move furniture outside.** Our furniture is indoor quality only and can be ruined by weathering of all sorts. We recommend you set up your own camp chairs out on the deck and around the fire.
- **There is no cooking allowed in the Cabins with exception of the microwave.** Cooking causes grease spills, burnt furniture and lasting odors. Food attracts small animals. Also, the Cabins are made of wood and cooking increases fire danger.
- **Fires must be in designated areas only.** Fire pits are provided for Cabin guests. To reduce fire danger, fires are allowed only in fire pits. Open flames are not permitted at any time inside the Cabins. **Wood gathering is prohibited. This includes drift wood. No vegetation may be removed from the area. Wood is available at the Marina store.**
- **Cabin Capacity is 8 people for Elkhorn and 6 people for Deer Ridge.** Too many people cause destruction to the Cabins so we ask that you stay within capacity. Also, you may have no more than 2 vehicles per Cabin.
- **Parking.** Two vehicles are included with your Cabin fees. Any additional vehicles must pay an additional \$10 per vehicle. Parking is provided behind the cabins. Additional parking is available just east of the Cabins.
- **There are no additional camp units when staying in the Cabins.** You are not allowed to use a camper trailer in the parking lot or pitch tents around the Cabin. You must buy a camping site for any additional camp units.

- **Individuals under 16 years of age must be directly supervised by an adult over 21 years of age.** It is our experience that kids enjoy jumping on furniture, twisting knobs and poking holes. Please do not leave your children unattended.
- **Leave it the way you found it.** Have a good time, but leave it the way you found it. Light cleaning is required before you leave, inside and out. \$100 deposit refund may take up to 10 days.

When You Leave

CHECK OUT TIME IS 12:00. Fees may apply if you exceed this.

- **Thoroughly clean the cabin.** Please clean under the beds and tables. Sweep out all dirt and debris. Remove all garbage and place it in the dumpsters. Even small amounts of food can attract rodents, ants, or flies. A broom and dustpan are located in the cabin. *You will be charged \$50 if our staff has to spend a lot of time cleaning up after you. If there are damages to the Cabin, you will be charged the amount to repair the Cabin, which may be more than the \$100 cleaning deposit depending on the severity of the damage. Smoking or pets in or around the Cabin will result in a loss of your deposit.*
- **Wipe out the microwave and refrigerator.** The appliances should look as clean when you leave as they did when you arrived.
- **Wipe down the table, chairs, bunk beds, and appliances.** Cleaning supplies are provided. Please do not take the cleaning supplies or they will be taken out of your deposit.
- **Pack out everything that you packed in.** Anything that you leave has to be picked up by someone, please remove anything that you brought with you.
- **Lock the Cabin and return the key to the key holder on the wall.** *There is a \$20.00 charge for a lost key.*
