Settlers of Rockport built The Old Church in 1892. For 60 years, church services, meetings, dances, weddings and other community events were held in this white frame, one-room building.

- ◆ Use of open flames, including candles, stoves, lanterns and smoking is prohibited
- ◆ Use of tape, nails or tacks on walls or windows is prohibited

Building rental fees are \$450 daily. The Old Church may be reserved up to 11 months in advance by calling 1-800-322-3770 or (801) 322-3770. A \$150 cleaning deposit is required and is refunded if the building and grounds are left in good condition. For pre-arrival arrangements, please call (435) 336-2241.
