

Antelope Island State Park
25th Annual Bison Roundup

General Information and Registration Instructions

Dates and Times:

Dates: October 28 and 29, 2011

Times: Main park gate opens at 6:00 a.m.
Range Ride starts 8:30 a.m.

Mandatory Ride Orientation: 8:00 a.m. both mornings at the Fielding Garr Ranch. All riders must attend the meeting(s) in order to ride and be assigned to a group.

Camping: For those wishing to camp at the Fielding Garr Ranch, you may check-in Thursday, October 27 starting at 12 noon. The overnight camping fee is \$15/night/vehicle.

Required Fees: (Please indicate number of riders and amount paid on Range Ride Registration and Payment Form)

Due at time of registration:

\$30/rider registration fee, payable by check, cash, money order, Visa, Master Card or American Express. The registration fee includes a souvenir bandana and entertainment. Payment must be postmarked on or before October 21, 2011 to avoid a \$10 late registration fee. Registrations received after October 22, 2011 will be assessed a \$10 late fee.

All additional fees collected upon entrance to Antelope Island:

\$9 Day use fee OR

\$15 Overnight camping fee per vehicle

Rider Preference: (Please indicate days you will ride and group preference on Range Ride Registration and Payment Form)

Friday, October 28, will be the main push to move the bison from the southern portion of the Island to the handling facilities on the North end of the island. Saturday any bison left on the range will be moved to the handling facilities. Please be aware the last few years, the animals have been rounded up on the first day.

Riders will be broken into two groups, an aggressive group that will push the animals. The second group is for those wishing a more leisurely ride. This group will ride in a line, creating a "curtain" to push any bison left behind. Groups will be lead by Sheriffs' Posse members and Antelope Island's Trail Patrol.

Optional dinner hosted by Friends of Antelope Island: (Please indicate the number of people who will be eating on the Range Ride Registration and Payment Form)

The Friends of Antelope Island, a non-profit organization whose mission is to enhance the visitors' experience on the Island, will host a dinner on Friday, October 29 from 6 – 9 p.m. at the Fielding Garr Ranch barn. Entertainment will begin at 7:00 p.m. at the barn.

General Information:

- Weed-free hay is required.
- No refunds will be given.
- Only registered riders may participate in the Range Ride.
- Riders must be at least 18 years of age.
- For the safety of your dog, no dogs will be allowed in camp or on the trail.
- Camping is permitted in designated areas only. No vehicles or equipment will be allowed in the fenced or wetland areas.
- Any fire restriction in place at the time of the roundup will be enforced.
- Cultural resources on Antelope Island are protected and must not be removed.
- By order of the Davis County Sheriff, no alcohol will be consumed prior to, or on the trail. Violators will be asked to leave the island and may be issued a citation.
- No confirmation will be mailed.
- Roundup memorabilia, food and drinks will be available for purchase.
