

MINUTES OF THE UTAH RECREATIONAL TRAILS ADVISORY COUNCIL

Julie P brought meeting to order. The council members introduced themselves.

John handed out a new roster of the Council members.

John handed out a new priority list reflecting the Council's first rating and ranking efforts.

Julie P asked for a wrap up of last year. John explained about the budget situation.

Julie P asked if the Urban Trails money had been awarded. John said all \$250,000 was awarded to Salt Lake City last year, to go from Redwood Road north to the Davis County line.

John gave a little background about the federal money we will be getting this year from the Recreational Trails Program (RTP). There was no state money appropriated.

Final meeting for grants will be scheduled sometime in August.

Purpose of this meeting is to eliminate some of the projects on the list for whatever reason the Council sees fit, so there will be enough time during the summer to visit the remaining projects. John needs the questions the Council has so when he does site visits he can get those answered and what are two or three of the projects the Council would like to visit.

John said the Council does not fund BMX track projects and hasn't previously funded bike lanes. John thought the UDOT Enhancement Program was more appropriate to fund bike lane projects. Julie has spoken with the planner on these projects and the planner said the same thing, those projects shouldn't have been sent in for our trails funding.

Also John mentioned there was a State Parks project that was submitted without his knowledge that shouldn't have been since John already sent money to that project. So John took that project off the list (#31).

Number 26 East Mtn Wilderness Park; Helene made the motion to remove that project from the list. Josh seconded the motion all members were in favor.

Number 15 Lindon Heritage Trail; Dan made the motion to remove this project from the list. Josh seconded the motion all members were in favor.

Number 28 Mendon Safe Route to School; Dan made the motion to remove. Josh seconded that motion all members in favor.

Number 3 Confluence Nature Park Bridge; Helene made the motion to remove. Josh seconded that motion all members in favor.

Number 25 Centerville Bike Route; Dan made the motion to remove. Josh seconded that motion all members were in favor.

Number 20, Wasatch Blvd Trail; Helene made the motion to remove. Josh seconded that motion all members were in favor.

Number 30 Pugh Canyon to Tom's Canyon Trail; with discussion from the Council, it was recommended to recommend to the project leader to have this project resubmitted next year. Council was all in favor to remove this from this year's project list.

Number 8 Sanpitch Recreation and Heritage Center; Dan made the motion to remove. Josh seconded that motion all members were in favor.

Number 14 Pfeifferhorn Trail; after some discussion it was decided to keep this project on the list.

Number 27 Wellsville Dam Park Trail and Bridge; after some discussion it was decided to keep this project on the list with maybe some modifications.

Number 17 West Valley City Crosstowne Trail; after some discussion it was decided to keep this project on the list.

Number 13 River Connector Trail; Josh made the motion to remove. Helene seconded that motion all members were in favor.

Number 11 IHC Trailside Connector; David made the motion to remove. Camillea seconded that motion all members were in favor.

Number 22 Jordan River Equestrian Trail; after some discussion it was decided to keep this project on the list.

Dan's concerns:        -Marina Park Trailhead - \$100,000 for a 1/5 a mile, concrete/asphalt, slope angle

Josh's concerns:      -Marina Park Trailhead – this was submitted last year, cost estimates are way high, location

Helene concerns:     -Pipe Dream – prescriptive easement rights, right of way secure
