APPROVAL OF AUGUST 4, 2009 MINUTES

David Olsen made the motion to approve the minutes. Helene seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

REVIEW OF 1ST RATING & RANKINGS

John asked the council to refer to the first rating and ranking spreadsheet of the grant requests.

Helene made the motion to eliminate projects Jones Heritage Trail, Historical Emigrant Trail, Eagle Mtn City Overland Trails, Utah and Salt Lake Canal Trail, Little Valley Trail Crossing, Lindon Heritage Trail and Big Cottonwood trail. David Olsen seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. David Jeppesen would like to review the Historical Emigrant Trail project before it is completely thrown out. The council discussed the Historical Emigrant trail and Helene made the motion to eliminate the Historical Emigrant trail, David Olsen seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

David Olsen made the motion to eliminate the 600 North Trail project, Helene seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

David Olsen made the motion not to make a site visit to Deer Valley project but to have John make a phone call to verify where that project will be grooming. Helene seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

David Olsen made the motion that the Upper Mirror Lake project does not need a site visit, Dan seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

David Olsen made the motion that the Slick Rock Trailhead does not need a site visit but this project maybe better funded by the motorized trails grants. Dan seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. John will talk to Fred Hayes about having the motorized side to either fund half or even the entire project.

David Olsen made the motion that the Laverkin Creek project does not need a site visit just a phone call. Sean seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Marcy made the motion to eliminate the Red Canyon project, Sean seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

John asked the Council to let him know what projects they would like to visit and what questions they would like answered.
