MONTE CRISTO SNOWMOBILE TRAIL CLOSURES

Salt Lake City – Snowmobilers headed to the Monte Cristo trail area should be aware of closures to portions of the trail in the Curtis Creek/Ant Flat area.

State Route 39 from Curtis Creek to the Woodruff gate is closed to all vehicles, including snowmobiles, through February 28 for pipeline construction.

Also, Ant Flat Road between Highway 39 and Hardware Ranch is closed now until December 15. From December 15 through January 1, Ant Flat Road between Hardware Ranch and Scare Canyon will be closed.

Until January, it is not possible to make a complete circuit of Curtis Creek Loop. If you plan to ride this loop, be sure to take extra gas for a two-way trip. After January 1, Ant Flat Road will be allowed to fill in with an 18-inch base of snow, then, snowmobile grooming will begin.
