

Palisade Cabins



Camp in a comfortable cabin, a great new alternative to RV and tent camping at beautiful Palisade State Park.

Available year-round, the Taylor Made, Bird House and Tripp Lodge cabins have all the comforts of home with panoramic views overlooking the park and Palisade Reservoir.

- ◆ Cabins are available two days to four months in advance by reservation only
- ◆ \$60 per night Sunday through Thursday
- ◆ \$80 per night Friday, Saturday and holidays
- ◆ Security deposit required

Reservations can be made by calling (801) 322-3770 in Salt Lake City or toll-free at 1-800-322-3770, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday or anytime at stateparks.utah.gov.

Each cabin provides:

- ◆ Sleeping accommodations for up to eight people
- ◆ Lighting, electrical outlets and cooling/heating unit
- ◆ Kitchenette with sink, microwave and refrigerator
- ◆ Modern restroom with shower
- ◆ Table and chairs
- ◆ Locking door with key
- ◆ Barbeque grill and picnic table located outside

Visitors should bring:

- ◆ Bedding, such as sleeping bags and/or sheets, blankets and pillows
- ◆ Camping-style cookware and cooking supplies
- ◆ Eating utensils
- ◆ Towels and washcloths

Please follow these rules:

- ◆ No cooking allowed in cabins
- ◆ Only appliances designed for indoor use are allowed
- ◆ No pets allowed in or around cabins
- ◆ No smoking in cabins
- ◆ Parking accommodations for two vehicles only
- ◆ Renters are responsible for light cleaning upon leaving
- ◆ Check-in: 3 p.m. / Check-out: Noon
