This program offers Boy Scout Troops a unique opportunity to complete the Citizenship in the Nation Merit Badge in Utah's First Capital Building. Troops spend a Friday evening and Saturday morning in the Legislative Hall of the Territorial Statehouse, discussing important American documents and learning about our government through fun inter-active games. All the requirements for this required merit badge will be completed. Participants will also gain understanding into the advantages of being a state rather than a territorial, as they tour the Territorial Statehouse, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Museum staff will lead the requirement filling activities.

Troops are responsible for sleeping gear and all meals. There is a multipurpose building (POD) located on the Parks grounds that troops are welcome to sleep in. The floor is hard, but it has a small kitchen, with refrigerator. Propane stove and Dutch ovens are welcome just outside the door on the POD. Roller skating and basketball are available in the POD during free time.

Registration and a fee of \$15.00 a scout is required. Leaders are free.
